

RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR RETIREE HEALTH BENEFITS

WHEREAS, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority (RVRSA) has agreed to bear costs of the presently existing hospital, surgical and dental coverage including costs of employees who retire under the rules of the New Jersey Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) as set forth in the current collective negotiations agreement between the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority and Local 945 Teamsters; and

WHEREAS, the RVRSA agrees to pay the premium or periodic charges for the benefits to all eligible retired employees covered under the program, if such employees retired from a State or locally-administered retirement system effective after the dated the employer adopted the State Health Benefits Program on a benefit based on 25 years or more of service credited in such retirement system, excepting the employees who elected deferred retirement, but including the employees who retired on disability pension based on fewer years of service credit in such retirement system and also to reimburse such retired employees for their premium charges under Part B of the Federal Medicare Program covering the retired employees and their spouses in accordance with the regulations of the State Health Benefits Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage authority as follows:

1. The RVRSA hereby elects to adopt the provision of NJSA 52:14-17.38 and adhere to the rules and regulations promulgated by the State Health Benefits Commission to implement the provisions of that law. This resolution affects employees as shown on the attached Chapter 48 Resolution Addendum. It is effective on the 1st day of July, 2010.
2. Adoption of this Resolution does not free RVRSA of the obligation to pay for post-retirement medical benefits of retirees or employees who qualified for those payments under any Chapter 88 or Chapter 48 Resolution adopted previously by this governing body.
3. Resolution will remain in effect until properly amended or revoked with the State Health Benefits Program. RVRSA recognizes that, while it remains in the State Health Benefits Program, it is responsible for providing the payment for post-retirement medical coverage as listed in the attached Chapter 48 Resolution Addendum for all employees who qualify for this coverage while this Resolution is in force.
4. RVRSA is required to provide the Division of Pensions and Benefits complete copies of all contracts, ordinances, and resolutions that detail post-retirement medical payment obligations it undertakes. It also recognizes that it may be required to provide the Division with information needed to carry out the terms of this Resolution.
5. Resolution 07-041 adopted on June 14, 2007 is revoked in its entirety.

6. Resolution 07-035 adopted on May 10, 2007 is revoked in its entirety.
7. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.
