

Resolution 11-039

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF
CONTRACT FOR INTERCEPTOR SEWER ODOR
AND CORROSION CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority ("RVRSA") issued a Notice to Bidders for the receipt of sealed proposals for the performance of sanitary interceptor sewer odor and corrosion control services; and

WHEREAS, the RVRSA received bids on April 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the apparent lowest responsible bidder, Siemens Water Technologies Corp., submitted a bid in the amount of \$ \$186,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the bids have been reviewed by legal counsel and staff of the RVRSA to determine compliance with the bid specifications in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by the apparent low bidder, Siemens Water Technologies Corp., was deemed in compliance with the legal and technical requirements set forth in the bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, the RVRSA has determined that the bid of Siemens Water Technologies Corp., is the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, funding for these services is available in Line Item 550.58 to provide funding for the entire contract amount; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority as follows:

1. The RVRSA hereby awards a contract to Siemens Water Technologies Corp., in the amount not to exceed \$186,000.00.

2. The Executive Director is authorized and directed to execute a contract with Siemens Water Technologies Corp., for the performance of sanitary interceptor sewer odor and corrosion control services.

3. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.


