

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ONE YEAR EXTENSION
OF CONTRACT FOR INTERCEPTOR SEWER ODOR
AND CORROSION CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority ("RVRSA") issued a Notice to Bidders for the receipt of sealed proposals for the performance of sanitary interceptor sewer odor and corrosion control services and awarded a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Siemens Water Technologies Corp., in the amount of \$191,200.00 by Resolution 12-044, adopted May 10, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the bid solicitation included a provision allowing for the extension of the contract period for one year from November 26, 2012 to November 25, 2013, in an amount not to exceed 80,000 gallons, at the sole discretion of the RVRSA and subject to the availability of funds therefore; and

WHEREAS, the RVRSA has determined that it is in the best interest of the Authority to extend the contract for an additional one year period at a cost of \$191,200.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for these services is available in Line Item 520.19 to provide funding for the entire contract amount; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority as follows:

1. The RVRSA hereby extends the contract awarded to Siemens Water Technologies Corp., to include the period from November 26, 2012 to November 25, 2013, in the amount of \$191,200.00.
2. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.


