RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACT FOR UNIFORM RENTAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority (hereinafter "RVRSA") desires to enter into a contract for the provision of UNIFORM RENTAL services for the employees of the RVRSA; and

WHEREAS, the RVRSA solicited for quotes to provide uniform rental services to the RVRSA for a twelve (12) month period, with an option to renew such contract for an additional twelve (12) month period at the sole discretion of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the quote of UniFirst Corporation, having offices at 64 South Jefferson Road, Whippany, NJ 07099, being the apparent lowest quote, was reviewed by the Authority's Staff to determine compliance with the specifications; and

WHEREAS, based upon its review of the quoted price proposed, the Authority has determined that it would be in the best interests of the Authority to award a contract to UniFirst Corporation, in a form acceptable to the Executive Director of the RVRSA, for a term of twelve (12) months in accordance with the prices set forth in the Customer Service Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof, and to extend the contract for an additional twelve (12) month period at the same quoted prices applicable to months 13 to 24, subject to the availability of financing therefore; and

WHEREAS, the CFO has certified that sufficient funds are available in line item 14-01-506-080 for months 1 to 12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockaway Valley

Regional Sewerage Authority as follows:

REQUIREMENTS SUPPLIED. The Customer orders from UniFirst Corp. ("UniFirst") rental and related services for all of Customer's requirements for garments and other items ("Merchandise") of the type listed on the reverse, at the prices and upon the terms and conditions outlined. Additional Merchandise requested by Customer, verbally or in writing, will also be covered by this Agreement. All rental Merchandise supplied to Customer remains the property of UniFirst. Customer warrants that it is not subject to, and that his Agreement does not interfore or conflict with, any existing agreement for the supply of the Merchandise or services covered.

PERFORMANCE QUARANTEE: Underest QUARANTEES TO DELIVER HIGH QUALITY SERVICE AT ALL TIMES. At terms of Merchandise cleaned, finished, inspected. equired and delivered by Unifirst will meet or exceed its quality standards, or non-conforming thems will be replaced by the next scheduled delivery day at no cost to Customer, thems of rankel Merchandise requiring replacement due to normal wear and lear will be replaced at no cost to Customer, save for any applicable personalization and set-up charges.

Customer expressly waives the right to terminate this Agreement during the initial term or any extension thereof for deficiencies in services and/or quality of Merchandise unless:
(1) complaints are first made in writing to UniFirst which set forth the precise nature of any deficiencies: (2) UniFirst is afforded at least sixty (60) days to correct any deficiencies (i) complaints are that made at writing to Differst which set delicencies complained of unit is such as the experiment of the companion of unit is the event Customer complies with the foregoing and UniFirst falls to correct such deficiencies. Customer may terminate this Agreement by written notice to UniFirst; providing that all previous belonces due UniFirst have been paid in full and that all other conditions to terminate have been satisfied. Any debuy or interruption of the service provided for in this Agreement, by reason of acts of God, lires, explosions, strikes or other industrial disturbances, or any other cause not within the control of UniFirst, shall not be deemed a breach or violation of this Agreement.

TERM AND RENEWAL. This Agreement is offactive when signed by both the Customer and UniFirst Location Manager and continues in effect for 60 months after installation of Maschandise (for new customers) or of any renewal date. This Agreement will be renewed automatically and continuously for multiple successive 60 month periods unless Gustomer or UniFirst gives written notice of non-renewal to the other at least 90 days prior to the next expiration date

PRICES AND PAYMENTS. All charges are based upon the total Merchandise covered by this Agreement and may change as the amount of such Merchandise is increased or devenaged. Any Merchandise payments required nursuant to this Agreement will be at UniFirst's list replacement price(s) than in effect. If an authorized Customer representative is lest available to receive and actimoviledge delivery of Merchandiso. Customer authorizes UniFirst to make delivery and assumes responsibility for related chargosi involves.

On an annual basis, the prices then in effect will be increased by the greater of the annual percent increase in the Consumer Price Index - All Urban Consumers, Series ID: CHIRODODSAG, other goods and services or by 5%. Additional price increases and other charges may be imposed by separate written netice or by notation on Customer's invoice. Customer may, however, decline such additional increases or charges by notifying UniFirst in writing within landays after receipt of such notice or notation.

Prices are based on lifty-two weeks of service per yoar. Customer agrees to pay all charges on receipt of invoice or, if a pre-approved charge customer, per stantard terms. MERCHANDISE. Customer acknowledges that Merchandiso supplied is for general occupational use and, except as expressly specified below, affords no special user protections.

Flame Resistant. If the Merchandles supplied is designated as flame resistant ("FR"), it is intended only to prevent the ignition and burning of labric away from the point of high fund improgement and to be self-extinguishing upon removal of the ignition source. FR garments will not provide significant protection from burns in the immediate area of high heat contact, due to thermal transfer through the tabric and/or destruction of the fabric in the area of such exposure. FR garments are designed for continuous wear as only a secondary level of protection. Primary protection is still required for work activities where direct or significant exposure to heat or open flame is likely to occur,

Visibility. If the Merchandise supplied is visibility wear, it is intended to provide improved conspicuity of the woard under daylight conditions and when illuminated by a light source of sufficient candidepower at night. It is Customer's responsibility to determine the level of conspicuity needed by wearen under specific work conditions. Further, Customer agrees that the garments alone do not ensure conspicuity of the weater and that additional safety procautions may be necessary. The garments supplied satisfied particular Class II, an Class III ANSI/SEA standards only when they were now and unused and only if so tabelled. Customer acknowledges that usage and laundering of visibility Merchandisc will adversely affect its conspicuity.

Healthcans/Food-Related. Healthcare and food-related customers acknowledge that (1) Unifirst does not guarantee or warrant that the Marchandise selected by Customer or that processed garments delivered by Uniffirst will be appropriate or sufficient to provide a hygienic level adequate for Customer's needs, and (2) optional poly-bagging' is recommended to reduce the risk of cross-contamination of Merchandise and the failure to utilize such service may adversely affect the efficacy of Uniffirst's hygienic dearing. process, (* Poly-hag services Incur additional charges.)

Customer agrees to notify all employees that the Merchandise is for general occupational use and, except for FR or visibility garments, affords no special wearer protections. Customer further agrees to notify all employees who will be wearing FR or visibility garments that such garments provide only limited protection as set forth herein and only under certain conditions. In addition, Customer extraordedges that (1) Customer has unitalerally and independently determined and selected the nature, stylo, performance characteristics, number of changes and scope of all Merchandise to be used and the appropriateness of such Merchandise for Customer's specific needs or intended uses, (2) Unifiers does not have any obligation to advise, and has not advised. Customer concerning the fitness or suitability of the Merchandise for Customer's intended uses, (3) Unifiers does not have any obligation to advise, and has not advised. Customer concerning the fitness or suitability of the Merchandise for Customer's intended uses, (3) Unifiers on presentation, warranty or coverant regarding the performance of the Merchandise (including without finitation FR and visibility garments), and (4) Unifiers should be responsible or liable for any injury or harm suffered by any Customer employees while wearing or using any Merchandise. Customer agrees to indemnify and hold hamiless Unifiers and its employees and against from and against all claims, injuries or damages arise from any alleged defects in the Merchandise, whether or not such claims, injuries or damages arise from any alleged defects in the Merchandise,

Customer agrees not to contaminate any Merchandise with asbestos, heavy metals, solvents, inks or other hazardous or toxic substances ("contaminants"). Customer agrees to pay UniFirst for all Merchandise that is lost, stolen, damaged or abused beyond repair.

If any Marchandise supplied hereunder is Marchandise that (1) UniFirst does not stock for whitever reason (Including due to style, ontor, size or brand). (2) consists of non-UniFirst manufactured or distomized FR gamments, or (3) consists of gamments that have been permanently personalized (in all cases known to "Non-Standard Merchandise"), then, upon the discontinuance of any service hereunder at any time for any reason, including expiration, termination, or cancellation of this Agreement, with or without cause, detailor of any Non-Standard Merchandise from Customer's service program, or due to employee reductions (in each case a "Discontinuance of Service"). Customer will purchase at the time of such Discontinuance of Service all affected Non-Standard Merchandise Items (here in UniFirst's Inventory (in-service, shelf, as well as any manufacturer's supplies ordered for Customer's use), paying for same the replacement charges then in effect.

As a condition to the termination of this Agreement, for whatever reason, Customer will return to UniFirst all Standard Merchendise in good and usable condition or pay for same at the replacement charges then in effect.

OBLIGATIONS AND REMEDIES. If Customer broaches or terminates this Agreement before the expiration date for any roason (other than for UniFirst's faiture under the performance guarantee described above). Customer will pay UniFirst, as liquidated damages and not as a penalty (the parties acknowledging that actual damages would be difficult to reliculate with reasonable cartainty) an amount equal to 50 percent of the average weekly amounts invoiced in the preceding 26 weeks, multiplied by the number of weeks remaining in the current term. Those damages will be in addition to all other obligations or amounts owed by Customer to UniFirst, including the return of Standard iderchandise or payment of replacement charges, and the purchase of any Non-Standard Merchandise items as set forth herein.

All disputes of whatever kind between Customer and UniFirst based upon past, present or future acts, whether known or unknown, and unsing out of or rolating to the negotiation, formation or performance of this Agreement shall be resolved exclusively by final and binding arbitration. The arbitration shall be conducted in the capital city of the state where Customer has its principal place of business (or some other location mutually agreed to by Customer and UniFirst) pursuant to the Expedited Procedures of the Communician Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association and shall be governed by the Federal Arbitration Act. Customer acknowledges that, with respect to all such disputes, it has voluntarily and knowingly warred any right it may have to a jury trief or to participate in a class action of class fligation as a representative of any other persons or class of persons, or to consolidate its claims with those of any other persons or class of persons, it this prohibition against class fligation shall be void and of no force and effect in that proceeding.
