RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH CONTRACT
38-CONSTRUCTION OF MONROE STREET AND HARRISON AVENUE PUMP
STATIONS AND ASSOCIATED SEWER CONSTRUCTION AND CONTRACT
39-OLD JERSEY CITY TRUNK SEWER RELINING

WHEREAS, there exists a need for the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority to engage professional engineering services related to the construction of Monroe Street and Harrison Avenue Pump Stations and Associated Sewer Construction (Contract 38) and the Old Jersey City Trunk Sewer Relining (Contract 39); and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40:11-1 et seq.) authorizes contracts for the provision of "Professional Services" which may be awarded without public advertising and competitive bidding therefore, provided a brief notice of the award is published and that the resolution and contract are kept on file and available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing services are professional services as defined in the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) which are permitted to be contracted without public bidding as set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a); and

WHEREAS, the RVRSA elected to solicit proposals for the performance of these services in an effort to obtain competitive proposals from qualified engineers, and issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for professional engineering services related to the construction of Monroe Street and Harrison Avenue Pump Stations and Associated Sewer Construction (Contract 38) and the

Old Jersey City Trunk Sewer Relining (Contract 39) on July 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Authority held a non-mandatory pre-proposal meeting on July 22, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Authority distributed the notice “Disclosure of Investment Activities in Iran” to all firms that requested an RFP; and

WHEREAS, the Authority distributed a document entitled “ADDENDUM TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PROFESSIONAL CONSTRUCTION PHASE ENGINEERING AND RESIDENT PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE SERVICES FOR CONTRACTS 38 & 39” in response to requests for information from the Engineering Firms that were raised at the non-mandatory pre-proposal meeting held on July 22, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Authority received Proposals from six (6) Engineering Firms by the July 29, 2014 deadline; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2014, such Proposals were reviewed and evaluated by RVRSA staff and the Infrastructure Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Committee evaluated each bid in accordance with the Evaluation Criteria and Methodology as set forth in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, following this evaluation, the Infrastructure Committee recommended the award of a contract to the firm of Kleinfelder East, Inc., with an office located at 321 Wall Street, Princeton, NJ 08540, as the most advantageous proposer; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Kleinfelder East, Inc., entitled, “Proposal For Professional Construction Phase Engineering and Resident

Project Representative Services For Contracts 38 & 39” dated July 28, 2014, is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N. J. A. C. 5:30- 5.4, B. K. Sandy Thai, as the Chief Financial Officer for the RVRSA certifies as to the monies being used to fund these professional services are available for financing in the 2014 Year Budget of the RVRSA at line item 14-EIT-38

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority as follows:

1. The Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority recognizes that Kleinfelder East, Inc. has an established reputation in the field of engineering matters related to sanitary sewage treatment facilities and construction project management, and that they possess the specialized abilities and resources to provide the expert engineering services necessary to meet the Authority’s needs.
2. The Executive Director of the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement for the provision of professional engineering services between the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority and the firm of Kleinfelder East, Inc., for the performance of the services outlined in the attached Proposal entitled, “Proposal For Professional Construction Phase Engineering and Resident Project Representative Services For Contracts 38 &39” dated July 28, 2014, in an amount not to exceed **\$402,930.00** and in the form attached to the Request for Proposals.
3. Notice of Contract Award shall be published in the Daily Record as required by law within 10 days of its passage.
