RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE RECEIPT OF BIDS FOR THE FILTRATION AND PHOSPHORUS REMOVAL PROJECT, CONTRACT NO. 41

WHEREAS, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority ("Authority") is required, pursuant to its wastewater discharge permit NJPDES NJ0022349, to achieve compliance with a phosphorus monthly average effluent limitation of 0.76 mg/L and to comply with a Carbonaceous Biochemical Oxygen Demand (CBOD) monthly average effluent limitation of 8 mg/L; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2016, by Resolution 16-119, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority ("RVRSA") authorized the application for a loan from the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure financing program for the Filtration and Phosphorus Project and by Resolution 19-098, adopted October 10, 2019, authorized the issuance of bonds for Contract 41, Filtration and Phosphorus Project; and

WHEREAS, RVRSA desires to authorize the advertisement and receipt of bids, pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq, for the Filtration and Phosphorus Project, Contract No. 41.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority

- 1. RVRSA hereby authorizes the advertisement and receipt of public bids for the Filtration and Phosphorus Control Facilities Project, Contract No. 41, pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.
- 2. The Executive Director, staff and consultants are authorized to take all appropriate measures necessary for the aforementioned procurement of the same.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.
