## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR INTERCEPTOR CLEANING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority (the "Authority") requires on-call Interceptor Cleaning Services; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has found it necessary to contract with an outside vendor to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11A-1 et seq., when the cost or price of any contract awarded by the contracting unit does not exceed the bid threshold, the contract may be awarded by the contracting unit without public advertisement for bids; and

WHEREAS, as set forth in the Quotation Record Form dated July 1, 2020 attached hereto and made a part hereof, at least two competitive quotations were sought for the performance of on-call Interceptor Cleaning services and in response the Authority received the lowest proposal from National Water Main Cleaning, attached herein, having a business office at 1806 Newark Turnpike, Kearny, New Jersey for Interceptor Cleaning Services and other needed services not to exceed \$30,000.00 to be billed at the following rates of \$430.50 per hour straight time (2-man crew), \$490.50 per hour overtime and \$545.50 per hour Sunday's and Holiday's and Mobilization/Demobilization (2-man crew) \$450.00; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose at line item 01-507-030

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority as follows:

- 1. That the Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute an Interceptor Cleaning Service agreement between National Water Main Cleaning, having a business office at 1806 Newark Turnpike, Kearny, New Jersey and the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority, in the not to exceed amount of \$30,000.00.
- 2. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.
